**SONATA COLLECTION ADDS ELEGANCE TO ACCENTS
FROM CAROLYN KINDER FOR MAGNUSSEN HOME**

HIGH POINT, N.C., April 14, 2005 – Elegant, with a touch of the provincial elegance from old Europe, the Sonata Collection by Carolyn Kinder for Magnussen Home features delicately curved iron work with leaf details and slate tops. Mirrored surfaces, as well as open filigree looks, add light and life to the collection.

“We named it Sonata because it’s like a song with all of its curling lyrical lines...it just makes you smile,” says Carolyn Kinder, president and chief executive officer of Carolyn Kinder, Inc. “Who can resist the exquisite combination of delicate filigree leaf ironwork with heavy, natural black slate? The contrast is both striking and beautiful.”

Among the Sonata introductions are hall chests, baker’s racks, screens, pedestals, nesting tables, game tables and dining tables. Many of the pieces are multifunctional, providing display and storage. Yet Sonata’s beauty lies mostly in its personality.

Antique bronze iron in a delicate filigree leaf pattern distinguishes the three **Nesting Tables** (Large: 27”W x 17”D x 27 5/8”H), which would be stunning in a sunroom, living room or even a bedroom. Textured glass tops add effervescence, while the open ironwork creates an airy feel.
